His grandfather whose name was Hugh Jackson, was a linen draper, near Carrickfergus, and had four sons, of whom the youngest, Andrew, was the father of the General. The oppression and misrule of the British government drove Andrew from his native country in 1765, and with his wife and two sons, Hugh and Robert, he sought an Asylum in the Waxhaw settlement, in South Carolina.
